## To Whom it may concern

Please submit my concerns to whom it may concern in relation the proposed New Century Park development, new housing and new roads around the Luton Airport and East of Luton area including small surrounding villages.

On the LLA/LBC plans, the proposed dual carriageway through the airport, taking traffic into a public park, seems far bigger than is needed for the offices proposed. This appears to be for a bigger development, presumably the 1000's of new homes being planned with at least 2 cars per household and the effect will unimaginable. Noise, fumes and excessive road usage will have a detrimental effect on residents both from an air pollution and noise pollution point of view.

It is very obvious that the extra traffic that will pass through the area as a result of the road being made easy access from Hitchin to the airport .

Then add to this the disturbance of 7 acre, 40 year old landfill site during the construction of New Century Park and the effects could be catastrophic with toxic waste fumes entering the atmosphere and potentially the water table. Office workers, residents, shoppers and school children local to the area could all be at risk of poisonous air.

Over two hectares of trees, some of those planted for us in the 1980s, would be lost to roads and car parks. The trees and CWS in the park provide an important wildlife habitat, and act as **a barrier to air and noise pollution, which cannot be lost** 

LLA want to grow even more over the coming years but the rapid increase in flights recently has brought millions more vehicles and more pollution, which at several places in the airport is at illegal levels. A major road will increase toxins in the air, and have a significant negative impact on health. Pollution from diesels and planes kills 40,000 people every year. It stunts children's lung growth, causes asthma, strokes and heart attacks, and shortens lives. **A housing development was recently refused because no mitigation for pollution was provided. There is no mitigation here**.
