The Hertfordshire County Council (Clothall 30) Modification Order 2022

The above Order made on 17th February 2022, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by:-

Adding to them the bridleway commencing at a junction with Clothall Restricted Byway 21 at TL 2919 2916 running west across Luffenhall Common for approximately 445 metres to a junction with Clothall Byway Open to All Traffic 12 and Weston Byway Open to All Traffic 39, opposite Weston Bridleway 36 (Lolleywood Lane) at TL 2875 2910.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Hertfordshire County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
