**The Hertfordshire County Council (Clothall 30)  
Modification Order 2022**

The above named Order, made on 17<sup>th</sup> February 2022, was confirmed without modification by Hertfordshire County Council on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2022.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to modify the Definitive Map and Statement by adding to them the bridleway commencing at a junction with Clothall Restricted Byway 21 at TL 2919 2916 running west across Luffenhall Common for approximately 445 metres to a junction with Clothall Byway Open to All Traffic 12 and Weston Byway Open to All Traffic 39, opposite Weston Bridleway 36 (Lolleywood Lane) at TL 2875 2910.

The Order becomes operative as from the date on which it was confirmed, but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, or any regulation made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he may, under paragraph 12 of Schedule 15 of the Act within 42 days from 10<sup>th</sup> November 2022, make application for the purpose of the High Court.
